

Notice A.Y. 2026-2027 | Camplus Milan Gorla

addressed to **University Students** for the Allocation of beds at the **University Residence**

The **Camplus Foundation**, a **Camplus** partner, works in the student housing sector dedicated to university students, aiming to support their academic careers through the management of student residences. As part of this objective, the Camplus Foundation provides residential facilities to ensure the best possible living, studying and community conditions for Italian and international students. This Notice (the "Notice") concerns the Camplus Milano Gorla University Residence located at **Via Stefanardo da Vimercate, 8 - 20128 - Milano (MI)** (the "Residence") managed by the Camplus Foundation and **financed by the European Union - "NextGenerationEU"** referred to in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) – Mission 4 – Component 1 – Reform 1.7 "Student Housing and Reform of Student Housing Legislation".

The Residence has **64 beds** in single and double rooms.

With this in mind, the Camplus Foundation, addressing exclusively **University Students** (hereinafter, "Students"), provides the following information regarding access to the Residence for **the 2026-2027 Academic Year**.

In order to promote the continuity of each student's university and personal experience at the Residence, the Notice provides for an Allocation duration of 12 months, starting **from September 1, 2026 to August 31, 2027**. On the application form it will still be possible to indicate the expected arrival date and the desired period of stay but, for the above purpose, any requests for less than 12 months or with an arrival date other than 1 September 2026 will be taken into consideration only based on the remaining availability of beds determined by the Camplus Foundation.

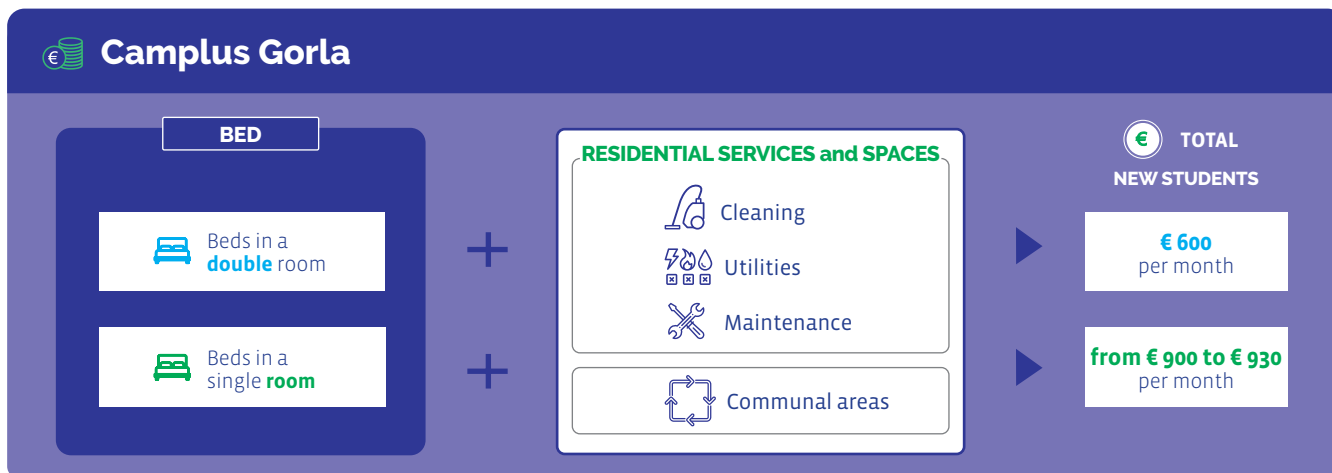
1. AMENITIES AND SERVICES

2. PRICES

The Residence has a different price based on the type of room allocated. The prices are **per person** and include, in addition to the allocation of a bed, the use of the areas and residential services provided in the Residence referred to in point 1 of this Notice. The prices below are based on a period of **12 months**. Any shorter allocations (subject to availability) may be subject to a price increase of up to 20% of the indicated price.



The prices indicated for each bed, broken down by room type, vary according to the features of the room (such as size, exclusive use of bathroom).



Resident students can access the income-based fee reductions described in article 2.1 below. They can also have a price reduction based on the number of years they have been at the residence.

2.1 FEE REDUCTIONS

As part of its institutional aims of promoting social integration and cultural education among young university students, the Camplus Foundation provides annual support for deserving students and/or those lacking financial means. This support is provided in the form of student housing agreements with **right-to-study organisations**, in accordance with article 4 below. Further fee reductions may also be available, at the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors.

More specifically, the Camplus Foundation offers students **3 income-based fee reductions**. All students who meet the following requirements can apply for the fee reductions **by April 07, 2026**, by sending an email to the address given in art. 7 below.

Requirements for access to income-based fee reductions:

- ◆ I.S.E.E (eligible for university entitlement benefits): Up to Euro 28,000¹
- ◆ Continue to meet the requirements for renewal (from the 2nd year in Camplus);
- ◆ Sign a 12-month contract with Camplus for the 2026-2027 academic year.

The Foundation will award the income-based fee reductions **by April 15, 2026**. Reductions will be allocated in ascending order of the I.S.E.E. scores. In the case of equal ISEE scores, priority will be given to the candidate who has been staying at the Camplus Residence for the longest period of time; if the scores are still equal, priority will be given to the youngest candidate and if the candidates are still equal, priority will be given to the Application with the earliest submission date.

¹The I.S.E.E. certification is issued based on the Single Self Declaration, which must be filled in and delivered to a Tax Assistance Centre (CAF) or to the INPS office responsible for the region or municipality of residence. With regard to I.S.E.E. certification, please note that the income, property and assets data refer to the year 2024 (Italian Decree Law 101 of 03/09/2019).

Please note that **it is the responsibility of the interested party to obtain the I.S.E.E. Certificate with the relevant protocol number** (e.g. INPS – I.S.E.E. – 2026- XXXXXXXX-00) and the note **"Applies to subsidised services for the right to university education"**, in good time for the application deadline. I.S.E.E. certificates with omissions and/or discrepancies found after checking by INPS (Italian National Social Security Institute) will not be accepted. The student must then resubmit the I.S.E.E. certificate and the "DSU" (self-declaration) after any discrepancies have been corrected.

3. ALLOCATION PROCEDURE

The Allocation process is different depending on whether the Student is already occupying the Residence ("Resident Student") or is obtaining a place at the Residence for the first time ("New Student").

Applications for **Resident Students** will only be accepted for the same Residence in which the Student is already housed. If a Student is already staying at a Camplus Residence and wishes to apply for a different Camplus Residence, they must submit a new Application for the Residence of interest, and will be considered a **New Student**.

*The time it takes for students to be contacted may vary depending on the number of requests for allocation received and any checks to be performed on the submitted documentation.

3.1 ALLOCATION CRITERIA

When submitting the Application, Students must meet the requirements as specified below:

For Resident Students

With this Notice, the Camplus Foundation allows students already residing in the Residence during the 2025-2026 Academic Year to apply for a bed for the 2026-2027 Academic Year as well, in order to favour the continuity of housing and support Students in their studies.

The Notice is addressed to Students enrolled at any School or Institute of university level, including institutions of artistic, musical and choreographic education, with the exception of online universities. Students must meet the following requirements:

- ◆ they must have complied with the Camplus Regulations during their stay at the Residence;
- ◆ they must have an identification number (enrolment number) or a document certifying enrolment at the relevant Italian University;
- ◆ they must not have any criminal convictions or pending charges;
- ◆ they must not have signs of any illnesses incompatible with community life.

Failure to meet even one of these Allocation requirements will result in the candidate's exclusion from the allocation process.

New Students

The Notice is addressed to Students who intend to enrol **by October 31, 2026** or who are enrolled at any School or Institute of university level, including institutions of artistic, musical and choreographic education, with the exception of online universities. Students must meet the following requirements:

- ◆ be aged between 18 and 30 at the starting date of the contract;
- ◆ they must have an identification number (enrolment number) or a document certifying enrolment at the relevant Italian University, or alternatively they must have declared during the application stage their intention to enrol at the relevant Italian University by October 31, 2026;
- ◆ they must not have any criminal convictions or pending charges;
- ◆ they must not have signs of any illnesses incompatible with community life.

Failure to meet even one of these Allocation requirements will result in the candidate's exclusion from the allocation process.

N.B. For **international exchange students** (erasmus, overseas, ...), the deadline by October 31, 2026 may vary depending on the university and the period of the student's stay.

3.2 ALLOCATION APPLICATION

For Resident Students

The Allocation Application for a Resident Student requires the completion, **from March 2, 2026 to March 30, 2026**, (the "Reapplication Deadline"), of the appropriate *Form* sent by the Camplus Management, by email. After that deadline, the student will only be able to apply as a New Student.

To ensure that the Reapplication is processed correctly, please note that the Form must be completed in full. Only one Form per student is permitted: if a Student completes more than one Form, only the most recent Form in order of time will be accepted.

The *Form* must be completed no later than the end of the Reapplication Period, with the following details:

- ◆ a Student who is re-enrolling in the first year, for the Academic Year 2026-2027 must indicate their **diploma grade**;
- ◆ a Student who is enrolling for the Academic Year 2026-2027 in a year other than the first year, must indicate the **arithmetical average grade for the examinations taken** up until the date of submission of the application. For the purposes of the average, only fully completed exams will be taken into account;
- ◆ Students enrolled in a master's or postgraduate degree or a university specialisation course must indicate the **grade of their first degree**.

Please note that this Form is considered a self-declaration, and therefore the person submitting it is responsible for all the information given. Any benefits obtained will be forfeited, if the information declared is subsequently found to be false or untrue. Untruthful statements are punishable under the Italian Penal Code and relevant laws (Articles 75 and 76 of Italian Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000).

For New Italian Students

A New Italian Student can submit the Application for Allocation by completing the online application **from March 2, 2026 to March 16, 2026** (the "Deadline"), using the form available on the website camplus.it at the following link **Application for New Allocation**.

To ensure that the Application for New Allocation is submitted correctly, please note that a complete Form must be submitted. Only one Application per Residence is permitted. If a Student completes more than one Application for the same Residence, only the most recent Application in order of time will be accepted.

The Form must be completed, **no later than the end of the Application Period**, except as otherwise provided in Article 3.6, with the following details:

- ◆ a Student who is enrolling in the Academic Year 2026-2027 and has not yet obtained a secondary school diploma, must indicate the **total value of the school credits obtained in secondary school years 3 and 4**;
- ◆ if the student has already taken the leavers' exam and obtained a grade, they must indicate the **grade**;
- ◆ a Student who in the Academic Year 2026-2027 will be enrolling or intends to enrol in a year of a university course other than the first year, must indicate the **arithmetical average of the examinations taken** up until the date of submission of the application. For the purposes of the average, only fully completed exams will be taken into account;
- ◆ Students enrolled in a master's or postgraduate degree or a university specialisation course must indicate their **degree grade**.

For New International Students

The Application Form for new international students ("International Students") must be submitted **from March 2, 2026 to March 16, 2026** (the "Deadline"), by completing the online form available on the website camplus.it, at the following link **Application for New Allocation**. Please note that only one Allocation Application can be completed. If the Student completes more than one Application, the most recent Application in order of time will be taken into account.

The online form must also indicate, no later than the end of the Application Period, except as otherwise provided in Article 3.6., the level of Italian Language Certification and/or a foreign language other than the native language.

3.3 RANKING

Campus Foundation will draw up a ranking for Resident Students, to whom beds will be allocated on a priority basis, and a ranking for the other Allocation applications.

The applications for assignment submitted by new students between March 2, 2026, and March 16, 2026, may be reviewed and assigned starting from March 17, 2026, limited to the places made available following the withdrawal of reconfirmations.

From March 31, 2026, the remaining places will continue to be assigned.

Places are awarded on the basis of the merit criteria listed below. Precedence will be given to Students wishing to remain at the Residence for an entire academic year.

Resident Students

- ◆ if the Student is enrolled in the first year of the university course, the **grade obtained in their secondary school diploma or equivalent in hundredths, will be taken into account** (e.g. 100/100 corresponds to 100 points, or 25/25 school credits correspond to 100 points if you have not yet obtained your diploma);
- ◆ for Students enrolling in course years after the first year, or on master's degree programmes, the **arithmetical average grade** indicated at the time of completion of the application will be taken into account. The student must indicate on their application the arithmetical average of the examinations taken up until the date of submission of the application;
- ◆ for students enrolled in a master's or doctoral degree programme or specialised school, the **degree grade** will be taken into account (e.g. 110/110 corresponds to 100 points), as indicated when submitting the application for a place.

In the event of a tie (same score), priority will be given to the candidate with the longest stay at the Campus Residence; if the scores are still identical, priority will be given to the younger candidate and if there is still no difference in score, precedence will be given to the Application submitted earlier.

If any of the academic grade details are missing, even if only partial, the Student will not be excluded but will not be able to obtain any merit score.

New Italian Students

- ◆ if the Student enrolls in years after the first year, or on a master's degree programme, the **arithmetical average grade** obtained up to the date of submission of the Application will be taken into account, based on all the exams completed by the date indicated;
- ◆ for students enrolled in a master's or doctoral degree programme or specialised school, the **degree grade** will be taken into account (e.g. 110/110 corresponds to 100 points);
- ◆ if the Student is enrolled in the first year of the university course, the **grade obtained in their high school diploma or the third and fourth year school credits in hundredths, will be taken into account** (e.g. 100/100 corresponds to 100 points, 25/25 school credits correspond to 100 points if you have not yet obtained your diploma).

The allocation criteria will take into account the availability, in relation to the type of room and the sex of the students already occupying the rooms.

In the event of a tie (same score), priority will be given to the younger candidate. If the scores are still identical, precedence will be given to the Application submitted earlier.

If any of the academic grade details are missing, the Student will not be excluded but will not be able to obtain any merit score.

New International Students

Scores for New International Students will be awarded on the basis of their knowledge of the Italian language and/or knowledge of a language other than their native tongue.

On the basis of language certifications, the merit score will be awarded according to the following scheme:

The allocation criteria will take into account the availability, in relation to the type of room and the sex of the students already occupying the rooms.

In the event of a tie (same score), priority will be given to the younger candidate. If the scores are still identical, precedence will be given to the Application submitted earlier.

If any of the academic grade details are missing, the Student will not be excluded but will not be able to obtain any merit score.

3.4 NOTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF ALLOCATION

Once the ranking has been drawn up, Camplus Management will send each Student an email ("Allocation Email") advising them of the result of their Application, with details of their eligibility status. The Allocation Email will only be sent to the email address given on the application form.

The Student is required to confirm their acceptance of the bed (the "Acceptance") **within 2 days**, under penalty of exclusion, from the date of receipt of the Allocation Email, according to the instructions given in that email.

3.5. CONTRACT

The relationship between the Camplus Foundation and the Student will be governed by a specific contract (the "Contract"); the Contract must be signed by the Student according to the terms indicated by Camplus Management in the notice, under penalty of exclusion.

The Contract may allow for tax allowances under Italian tax rules, in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated by law.

3.6. LATE APPLICATIONS

At the end of the Allocation Period, which is the date on which the Contract is signed by the Student, if any places remain available for allocation to New Students at the Residences listed in the Notice, Camplus Foundation may consider applications received after the end of the application period. In this case, in order to reduce Allocation times and with a view to welcoming as many Students as possible, the available places will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis, after the Allocation criteria have been checked.

Beds will be allocated until availability is exhausted and will be included in the ranking. Camplus Foundation will send the student a notice of allocation, by email.

The eligible Student is required to accept the allocated place within 1 day of the email being sent, under penalty of exclusion. If accepted within the terms indicated, Camplus Management will send the Student the Contract for signature, according to the stated terms and conditions, under penalty of exclusion.

4. AGREEMENTS WITH RIGHT-TO-STUDY ORGANISATIONS

The purposes of the Camplus Foundation include the social integration and cultural education of young university students. The Foundation therefore makes an annual contribution to the support of deserving and/or disadvantaged Students, through student housing agreements with local **Right-to-Study Organisations**.

The purpose of these agreements is to allocate beds on the basis of the rankings drawn up by the Right-to-Study Organisations.

The Camplus Gorla Residence is a property of Camplus International Srl managed by the Camplus Foundation, which also issued this Notice.

As part of its support activities, the Camplus Foundation reserves **75 beds in University Residences in the city of Milan for deserving and/or disadvantaged students selected by the University of Milan (UNIMI) and Bicocca University**.

5. TRUTHFULNESS OF STUDENT DECLARATIONS

The person declaring the information is responsible for all declarations made. Any benefits obtained will be forfeited if the information declared is found to be false or untrue. Untruthful statements are punishable under the Italian Penal Code and relevant laws (Articles 75 and 76 of Italian Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000). Camplus, using the means at its disposal, may carry out random checks on Student declarations, and may request additional documentation, where necessary.

6. PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRESIDENTIAL DECREE
