

Notice A.Y. 2026-2027 | Camplus Ferrara Darsena La Torre

addressed to **University Students** for the Allocation of beds at the **University Residence**

The **Pro Habitare srl**, a **Camplus** partner, works in the student housing sector dedicated to university students, aiming to support their academic careers through the management of student residences. As part of this objective, the Pro Habitare srl provides residential facilities to ensure the best possible living, studying and community conditions for Italian and international students. This Notice (hereinafter, the "Notice") concerns the Camplus Ferrara Darsena La Torre University Residence located in **Via Darsena - 44122 Ferrara (FE)** (hereinafter, the "Residence") managed by the Pro Habitare srl and candidate for **funding from the European Union - "NextGenerationEU"** referred to in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) – Mission 4 – Component 1 – Reform 1.7 "Student Accommodation and reform of Student accommodation legislation". The Residence has **313 beds** in single or double rooms in apartments.

With this in mind, the Pro Habitare srl, addressing exclusively **University Students** (hereinafter, "Students"), provides the following information regarding access to the Residence for **the 2026-2027 Academic Year**.

In order to promote the continuity of each student's university and personal experience at the Residence, the Notice provides for an Allocation duration of 11 months, starting from October, starting **from october 1, 2026 to august 31, 2027**. On the application form it will still be possible to indicate the expected arrival date and the desired period of stay but, for the above purpose, any requests for less than 11 months, for less than 11 months, or with an arrival date other than october 1 2026 will be taken into consideration only based on the remaining availability of beds determined by the Pro Habitare srl.

2. PRICES

Applications may be submitted for the allocation of accommodation at a **REDUCED RATE**, intended for capable and deserving university students, including those with limited financial means, in accordance with the provisions set out in the Call for Applications for the Allocation of Accommodation at a Reduced Rate (Ministerial Decree No. 481/2024), available at the following [link](#).

3. ALLOCATION PROCEDURE

The following is the allocation procedure for the Camplus Ferrara Darsena La Torre Residence:

*The time it takes for students to be contacted may vary depending on the number of requests for allocation received and any checks to be performed on the submitted documentation.

3.1 ALLOCATION CRITERIA

When submitting the Application, Students must meet the requirements as specified below.

The Notice is addressed to Students who intend to enrol **by October 31, 2026** or who are enrolled at any School or Institute of university level, including institutions of artistic, musical and choreographic education, with the exception of online universities. Students must meet the following requirements:

- ◆ be aged between 18 and 30 at the starting date of the contract;
- ◆ they must have an identification number (enrolment number) or a document certifying enrolment at the relevant Italian University, or alternatively they must have declared during the application stage their intention to enrol at the relevant Italian University by October 31, 2026;
- ◆ they must not have any criminal convictions or pending charges;
- ◆ they must not have signs of any illnesses incompatible with community life.

Failure to meet even one of these Allocation requirements will result in the candidate's exclusion from the allocation process.

N.B. For **international exchange students** (erasmus, overseas, ...), the deadline by October 31, 2026 may vary depending on the university and the period of the student's stay.

3.2 ALLOCATION APPLICATION

New Italian Student

The Application for Assignment for the New Italian Student must be made by completing, **from June 24 to July 08, 2026** (hereinafter, the "Deadline"), the appropriate online form on the campus.it website at the following link [Application for New Assignment](#).

To ensure that the Application for New Allocation is submitted correctly, please note that a complete Form must be submitted. Only one Application per Residence is permitted. If a Student completes more than one Application for the same Residence, only the most recent Application in order of time will be accepted.

The Form must be completed, **no later than the end of the Application Period**, except as otherwise provided in Article 3.6., with the following details:

- ◆ a Student who is enrolling in the Academic Year 2026–2027 and has not yet obtained a secondary school diploma, must indicate the **total value of the school credits obtained in secondary school years 3 and 4**;
- ◆ if the student has already taken the leavers' exam and obtained a grade, they must indicate the **grade**;
- ◆ a Student who in the Academic Year 2026–2027 will be enrolling or intends to enrol in a year of a university course other than the first year, must indicate the **arithmetical average of the examinations taken** up until the date of submission of the application. For the purposes of the average, only fully completed exams will be taken into account;
- ◆ Students enrolled in a master's or postgraduate degree or a university specialisation course must indicate their **degree grade**.

For New International Students

The Application Form for new international students ("International Students") must be submitted **from June 24 to July 08 2026** (the "Deadline"), by completing the online form available on the website campus.it, at the following link [Application for New Allocation](#). Please note that only one Allocation Application can be completed. If the Student completes more than one Application, the most recent Application in order of time will be taken into account.

The online form must also indicate, no later than the end of the Application Period, except as otherwise provided in Article 3.6., the level of Italian Language Certification and/or a foreign language other than the native language.

3.3 RANKING

The Pro Habitare srl will draw up a ranking for the Students.

Places are awarded on the basis of the merit criteria listed below. Precedence will be given to Students wishing to remain at the Residence for an entire academic year.

New Italian Students

- ◆ if the Student enrolls in years after the first year, or on a master's degree programme, the **arithmetical average grade** obtained up to the date of submission of the Application will be taken into account, based on all the exams completed by the date indicated;
- ◆ for students enrolled in a master's or doctoral degree programme or specialised school, the **degree mark** will be taken into account (e.g. 110/110 corresponds to 100 points);
- ◆ if the Student is enrolled in the first year of the university course, the **grade obtained in their high school diploma or the third and fourth year school credits in hundredths, will be taken into account** (e.g. 100/100 corresponds to 100 points, 25/25 school credits correspond to 100 points if you have not yet obtained your diploma).

The allocation criteria will take into account the availability, in relation to the type of room and the sex of the students already occupying the rooms.

In the event of a tie (same score), priority will be given to the younger candidate. If the scores are still identical, precedence will be given to the Application submitted earlier.

If any of the academic grade details are missing, the Student will not be excluded but will not be able to obtain any merit score.

New International Students

Scores for New International Students will be awarded on the basis of their knowledge of the Italian language and/or knowledge of a language other than their native tongue.

On the basis of language certifications, the merit score will be awarded according to the following scheme:

The allocation criteria will take into account the availability, in relation to the type of room and the sex of the students already occupying the rooms.

In the event of a tie (same score), priority will be given to the younger candidate. If the scores are still identical, precedence will be given to the Application submitted earlier.

If any of the academic grade details are missing, the Student will not be excluded but will not be able to obtain any merit score.

In the event that, on the deadline of the present notice, the Right-to-Study organisations have not yet entered into an agreement to allocate all or part of the accommodation places to Pro Habitare srl, the latter shall allocate the reserved and possibly unoccupied places to the other students on the ranking list, maintaining the same favourable economic conditions provided for in the agreement with the competent local Right-to-Study organisations, in compliance with Italian Ministerial Decree No. 481 of 26-02-2024 and according to what is set forth in point 4 of this Notice.

3.4 NOTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF ALLOCATION

Once the ranking has been drawn up, Camplus Management will send each Student an email ("Allocation Email") advising them of the result of their Application, with details of their eligibility status. The Allocation Email will only be sent to the email address given on the application form.

The Student is required to confirm their acceptance of the bed (the "Acceptance") **within 2 days**, under penalty of exclusion, from the date of receipt of the Allocation Email, according to the instructions given in that email.

3.5. CONTRACT

The relationship between the Pro Habitare srl and the Student will be governed by a specific contract (the "Contract"); the Contract must be signed by the Student according to the terms indicated by Camplus Management in the notice, under penalty of exclusion.

The Contract may allow for tax allowances under Italian tax rules, in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated by law.

3.6. LATE APPLICATIONS

At the end of the Allocation Period, which is the date on which the Contract is signed by the Student, if any places remain available for allocation to New Students at the Residences listed in the Notice, Pro Habitare srl may consider applications received after the end of the application period. In this case, in order to reduce Allocation times and with a view to welcoming as many Students as possible, the available places will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis, after the Allocation criteria have been checked.

Beds will be allocated until availability is exhausted and will be included in the ranking.

Pro Habitare srl will send the student a notice of allocation, by email.

The eligible Student is required to accept the allocated place within 1 day of the email being sent, under penalty of exclusion. If accepted within the terms indicated, Camplus Management will send the Student the Contract for signature, according to the stated terms and conditions, under penalty of exclusion.

4. AGREEMENTS WITH RIGHT-TO-STUDY ORGANISATIONS

Pro Habitare S.r.l., having among its purposes the social integration and cultural education of university students, annually contributes to supporting capable and deserving students, even if they lack financial means, through agreements for the allocation of accommodation places to the **Organizations for the Right to Education** territorially competent. Such agreements are intended to allocate a quota of no less than 30% of the accommodation places in the university residence to students identified through rankings drawn up by the regional bodies territorially competent for the right to education or by other institutions responsible for the right to education pursuant to the legislation in force at regional level.

In such cases, the Application for Allocation must be submitted through the relevant calls for applications and/or notices published on the websites of the Bodies for the Right to Education.

For the Academic Year 2026-2027, the Organization for the Right to Education territorially competent for the Camplus Ferrara Darsena La Torre Residence has, at its own discretion, entered into an agreement for the partial allocation of the accommodation places reserved pursuant to Article 8, paragraph 2, of Ministerial Decree No. 481/2024, for a total of 30 accommodation places in double rooms.

Pro Habitare S.r.l., as the operator of the Residence, therefore directly proceeds with the allocation of the remaining reserved quota, amounting to 64 accommodation places, of which 22 accommodation places in double rooms and 42 accommodation places in single rooms at a subsidized rate, through a specific private Call for Applications, the terms and conditions of which can be consulted at the following [link](#).

The aforementioned Call for Applications independently regulates the eligibility requirements, the procedures for submitting the Application, the criteria for drawing up the ranking and any allocation on a first-come, first-served basis, referring, insofar as possible, to the provisions of the Call for Applications for DSU scholarships for the Academic Year 2026-2027, in compliance with the social purposes and conditions established by Ministerial Decree No. 481/2024. Furthermore, the agreement entered into with the territorially competent Body for the Right to Education provides for the possibility of the full release of the 30 accommodation places in double rooms by 15 October. Should this occur, Pro Habitare S.r.l., as the operator of the Residence, will proceed with the allocation of the remaining accommodation places.

5. TRUTHFULNESS OF STUDENT DECLARATIONS

The person declaring the information is responsible for all declarations made. Any benefits obtained will be forfeited if the information declared is found to be false or untrue. Untruthful statements are punishable under the Italian Penal Code and relevant laws (Articles 75 and 76 of Italian Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000). Camplus, using the means at its disposal, may carry out random checks on Student declarations, and may request additional documentation, where necessary.

6. PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRESIDENTIAL DECREE
